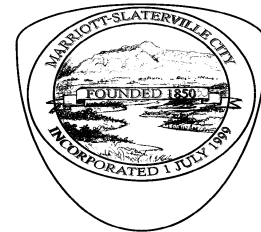

The 11th annual George E. Wahlen Veterans Tribute Run and Chili Cook-Off will be held Saturday, October 13, 2018. Co-sponsored by the George E. Wahlen Veterans Home and the First United Methodist Church (Marriott-Slaterville), this event raises funds to support the veterans residing at the George E. Wahlen Veterans Home.

The runs (5K and 10K) and one mile walk start at the George E. Wahlen Veterans Home (1102 N. 1200 W.) at 10 AM, and end at the First United Methodist Church (1339 W. 400 N.) in Marriott-Slaterville. The chili cook-off begins at 10:30 AM. Awards will be presented to the top male and female runners for the 5K and 10K, as well as for each age group male and female.
