## **Mayor and City Council**

Marriott-Slaterville City has two separate but equal branches of government. The Executive Branch is the administration led by the Mayor. The Legislative Branch is lead by a five (5) member City Council.

The Executive Branch handles daily operations, administration, proposes the budget, makes appointments, issues permits, handles complaints, implements policies and services, manages planning and zoning, among other responsibilities.

The Legislative Branch is the City Council. The City Council makes laws, adopts the budget, authorizes contracts, confirms appointments, and exercises oversight of the Executive Branch. Two (2) members of the City Council are elected from the East District, and two (2) from the West District. One (1) member of the City Council member is elected At-large. The City holds elections in odd numbered years. Contact the City Office at 801-627-1919 for more information.
