## Mayor's Emergency Message

The world has been pretty crazy lately. I never expected to have an earthquake in the midst of a global pandemic, but here we are. Marriott-Slaterville City is taking precautions as a result of COVID-19 (Coronavirus).

Among these adjustments include the cancellation of the following:

- ▶ Easter Egg Hunt.
- ▶ Art in April Show.
- ▶ April Spring Clean-up.
- ▶ Senior Lunch and Senior Activities.
- ▶ Senior Yoga.
- ▶ Youth Council Activities.
- ▶ City Meetings.

Parks will remain winterized and closed for reservations until further notice. Existing reservations for all parks and City facilities are canceled.

The City Office remains open with limited hours and capacity. Please call the City Office at 801-627-1919 rather than visit. The City is updating its website. The old website is offline as the City transitions to a new provider. The new website is still planned to launch in April. The new website is redesigned to improve quality and user interface.

Garbage service should continue as usual, if service interruptions occur from unforeseen events those will be communicated online. The City has not heard from the various irrigation companies about when irrigation season will begin this year. The City does not know if there will be a delay in getting water into the many ditches. The City is already prepared to activate the pressurized irrigation system as soon as the irrigation companies are able get water in the ditches. The pressurized system is planned to function as normal during the pandemic.

Also, the sewer system will function as normal. In light of the toilet paper shortage, the City asks the public to not flush items that may clog the system. Bona Vista water is safe to drink and use. First responders will respond to

emergencies with extra precaution to avoid possible exposure.
