Youth Mental Health First Aid

The National Alliance of Mental Illness finds one in five youth live with a mental health condition. CTC is working to improve mental health in our community.

A Youth Mental Health First Aid course will be held this fall. The course teaches about recovery and resiliency – the belief that individuals experiencing these challenges can and do get better. Topics include:

- Signs and symptoms of mental illnesses like: anxiety, depression, eating disorders, ADHD.
- Signs and symptoms of substance use.
- Managing a crisis and finding help.
