Winter Rules for the Road

As winter weather arrives to Marriott-Slaterville it is time to remember some rules for the road. There is no parking on any roads between midnight and 7:00 AM from December 1 and April 1, during a snowstorm, and 72 hours after a snowstorm. This is so the snow plows can operate. Violators will be towed. The County plows the most traveled roads first. Subdivisions and lesser traveled roads will be plowed last. Property owners with sidewalks are responsible to remove snow from the sidewalk within 24-hours after a snowstorm.
