I cannot believe the projects our little City accomplished over the last year. Nearly \$10 million in road and infrastructure improvements were completed. On Pioneer Road, the old failing bridge on the Plain City border was replaced along with a new road that will handle future traffic. 1200 West to 400 North has been reconstructed to accommodate the future as well. Secondary water, storm water, and road improvements were made on 700 South as well. Our City was able to fund these improvements mostly with grants. I appreciate our residents being patient and understanding as the City completed these projects.

I welcome our residents and businesses that moved to our City over the last year. There will be additional residents and business coming this year as well. Remember that Marriott-Slaterville City does not impose a municipal property tax. Our budget is balanced, and we have no City debt or bonds.
