Recycling Tour

One of the most frequent questions that the City receives involves recycling. This is because people hear stories about cities like Ogden struggling with their recycling programs. Marriott-Slaterville City is not Ogden. Marriott-Slaterville City has its own recycling program that is thriving. Waste Management currently handles Marriott-Slaterville City recycling and it continues to be very successful. In 2020, our residents recycled 68 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard. Residents also saved enough timber by recycling to preserve 831 mature trees, save 158 cubic yards of landfill space, and save 281,651 gallons of water.

Meet at the City Office at 11:00 AM where we will carpool to the recycling facility in Salt Lake City that processes our recycling material. Bring a mask and solid shoes.
