Winter Travel

Snow season brings travel and parking challenges in communities across the Wasatch Front. In Marriott-Slaterville City there are special rules that apply to snow season. No parking is allowed on roads between 12:00 Midnight and 7:00 AM from December 1 and April 1. No parking anytime during a snowstorm, and 72 hours after a snowstorm. This is so the snow plows can operate. Vehicles will be towed if illegally parked. Weber County plows the most traveled roads first in the City. Subdivisions and lesser traveled roads will be plowed last. Property owners with sidewalks are responsible to remove snow from the sidewalk within 24-hours after a snowstorm.
