Happy New Year! Welcome to 2022, with all of the hopes and challenges that await each of us.

One of the biggest challenges for this new year will be potential water shortages in the coming summer caused by the ongoing drought. None of us have lived in such a severe drought as we have experienced the last few years. Bona Vista is working hard to secure our culinary water supplies. Expect fines for water violations and limits on water waste. Fortunately, our community has worked hard to develop a pressurized water system that conserves vast amounts of secondary water resources. I ask each of you to help conserve water. Water costs are increasing and I will do my best to keep fee increases at a minimum.

I am pleased to report that the City has secured a grant for the reconstruction of 1700 South and 1200 West between the Ogden City border on 1700 South and 12th Street on 1200 West. It is anticipated that this project will cost approximately \$5,000,000 and commence around 2024. This road is in great need of an upgrade.

Remember that Marriott-Slaterville City does not impose a property tax on its residents. I plan to propose another balanced budget to the City Council this spring. We have no debt, and are working hard to plan for the future. Please support our local businesses, it helps sustain our community.

We plan to host all our traditional events throughout the year: Easter Egg Hunt, Fourth of July, Trunk-or-Treat to name a few. Summer will include the Garden Market so plan your garden now. I hope to see you at our events, and if you are new to the community please introduce yourself to me. Also, consider being a volunteer. There are many ways to give community

service from events to our Volunteers in Police Services (VIPS) Program. This program provides a great opportunity to serve in community policing.
