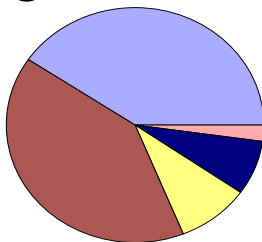
The Weber Mosquito Abatement District (Weber MAD) recommends watching for trouble spots where water can pool or collect such as: birdbaths, fountains, rain gutters, planters, tires, buckets, over-watered areas, and troughs.

Tentative Budget

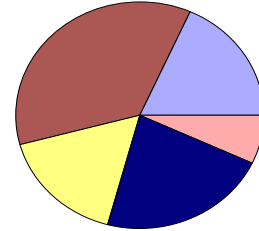
