## What You Should Know About Lateral Lines

Business and homeowners own their exterior lateral service lines for culinary water, secondary water, and for sewer lines and pumps on their property. They are also responsible for the maintenance and repair of these lateral lines from the connection in the street to the public line to the home or business being served.

If the lateral line breaks down, immediate repair is necessary to protect system integrity. Lateral line breakdowns can be complicated, requiring specialized equipment to locate the leak and repair the line.

Often a homeowner's insurance does not pay for lateral line repairs due to normal wear and tear, so you may have to pay out of out-of-pocket. Please review your insurance policy to see if you are covered for your lateral lines. Monitor your lateral lines and make regular repairs to keep them in service.
