Winter Rules for the Road

As winter arrives in Marriott-Slaterville it is time to remember some rules for the road. No parking on any roads between midnight and 7:00 AM from December 1 to March 1, during a snowstorm, and 72-hours after a snowstorm. This is so the snow plows can operate. Violators will be towed. The most traveled roads are plowed first. Subdivisions and lesser traveled roads are plowed last. Property owners with sidewalks must remove snow from the sidewalk within 24-hours after a snowstorm.
