City Government

Marriott-Slaterville City consists of two (2) separate but equal branches. The Mayor leads the Executive Branch. The Legislative Branch is governed by the City Council. The Executive Branch manages the daily operations of the City such as: municipal services, complaints, roads, parks, planning, pressurized irrigation, and other services.

The Legislative Branch approves: the budgets, ordinances, resolutions, contracts, appointments, and manages oversight. Two (2) members of the City Council are elected from the East District, and two (2) are elected from the West District. One (1) council member is elected Atlarge. There is a total of five (5) members of the City Council. City elections are held during odd numbered years. For questions call the City Office at 801-627-1919.
