Know Your Community

Cities and towns across the United States provide many valued services and programs. People are often surprised to learn all the things your community does. As part of our Education and Outreach Program at Marriott-Slaterville City, we are hosting a one (1) hour presentation to learn about our local government and the services provided to the community.

Please join us on **June 25, 2025, at 12:00 noon in the Legislative Chambers at 1570 West 400 North.** The topics will include: administrative functions, separations of executive and legislative powers, public safety, community events and programs, roads, sewer, secondary water, planning and zoning, code enforcement, and storm water.

Local Updates

 Budget. Balanced budgets are proposed to the City Council by the Mayor. The City Council will hold public hearings on June 19 on the budgets. The City has no debt and does not impose a City property tax.

- Central Weber Sewer. Central Weber Sewer Improvement District adopted a rate increase. For information call Central Weber at 801-731-3011.
- Secondary Water. The City's pressurized secondary irrigation system is operated under a Special District and appears as "Enhanced Services" on your Bona Vista water bill. The system may shut down during storm events to protect electronic components from lightning, and to prevent over watering. The system is treated about three (3) times during the summer with potassium to clear the lines of Bryozoa and debris that clogs the system. During treatment the system is also shut down for about 24-hours. Pink dye is used to make sure the treatment has circulated the system. Do not drink or use secondary water for anything but irrigation.
- Mosquitos. Weber Mosquito Abatement District recommends removing spots where water can pool. For mosquito problems around your home or business call Weber MAD at 801-392-1630.
- Roads. UDOT and the City will be conducting numerous road projects this year. Please prepare for delays and road construction.
