## Mayor's Message

There are many projects going on this summer. The City will be installing a sewer line on 1700 South. Bona Vista will also be installing a new upgraded water line on 1200 West and 700 South at the same time. Following the upgraded utilities and relocation of the power poles the road project will continue with the reconstruction of 1200 West and 1700 South. This project will continue into 2026. The City Council adopted balanced budgets proposed by the administration at their June meeting. The City maintains a good reserve and continues to operate with no debt and no property tax.
