Local Updates

- ▶ **Excessive Heat.** The excessive heat this summer is causing multiple problems. Overheating electronics shut down the City's pressurized secondary irrigation system to protect it from damage. As such, heat outages are occurring in addition to those caused by lighting and storms. Moss and Bryozoa thrive in the heat and clog the irrigation system. Additional potassium treatments are required, so the system will be down for service. Mosquitos are really bad in the heat, call Weber MAD at 801-392-1630. Weeds and dry vegetation cause fire hazards. Keep your yard and property clear of hazardous conditions.
- ▶ **Vandalism.** Due to vandalism, park restrooms remain locked. Please report suspicious activities.
