MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

The 2025 Municipal General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2025. Ballots will be mailed out to eligible voters starting on October 14, 2025. Voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the precinct in which they are registered. Voters can verify their registration status at www.vote.utah.gov. Voter registrations must be received by the county clerk before 5 p.m. October 24, 2025. However, voters may register to vote at an early voting location or at a polling location on Election Day. In-person voting will take place at the Weber Center (2380 Washington Blvd., Ogden) from Noon - 6 p.m. on October 28 - 31, 2025. On Election Day, November 4, 2025, voting hours will be from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m. at the Weber Center (2380 Washington blvd., Ogden) and the Ogden Valley Library (131 S 7400 E, Huntsville).
