City Government

Marriott-Slaterville City consists of two (2) separate but equal branches. The Mayor leads the Executive Branch. The Legislative Branch is governed by the City Council. The Executive Branch manages the daily operations of the City such as: municipal services, law enforcement, roads, parks, planning, pressurized irrigation, solid waste and recycling, and other services.

The Legislative Branch approves: budgets, ordinances, resolutions, contracts, appointments, and manages oversight. Two (2) members of the City Council are elected from the East District, and two (2) are elected from the West District. One (1) council member is elected At-large. There is a total of five (5) members on the City Council. City elections are held during odd numbered years. For questions call the City Office at 801-627-1919.
