2026 Projects

This year there is a number of infrastructure projects in the community. Thank you to residents on 1700 South who have been patient with road closures resulting from the sewer and water lines being installed. The sewer project is completed and Bona Vista will soon complete the new water line.

Soon the reconstruction of 1200 West south of the railroad and 1700 South to the Ogden border will commence. The existing road will be pulverized and removed. Next, new road base will be installed along with the curb, gutter, and sidewalk. Secondly, the other utilities will be installed or relocated. Lastly, the new asphalt will be paved and the road painted. This will take approximately eighteen (18) months to complete. Please plan for significant delays during construction and use alternate routes.

Slaterville Park will be under construction later this spring. During construction, the park is closed for

reservations and events. Approximately five (5) acres of park area will be added along with: an expanded sprinkling system, a walking trail, and a parking to help improve safety and use of the park. This project will take up to one (1) year to complete. Please plan ahead now to relocate to another park for any events this year.
