WHICH BALLOT?

You may only vote one party's ballot.

UNAFFILIATED



May request the **DEMOCRATIC** ballot. (It is not necessary to affiliate with the Democratic Party).
OR Affiliate with and receive the **REPUBLICAN** Party ballot.
May **only** vote one party's ballot.

REPUBLICAN



Will receive the **REPUBLICAN** ballot **ONLY**.

DEMOCRAT



Will receive the **DEMOCRATIC** ballot **ONLY**.

ALL OTHER PARTIES*



Will **NOT** receive a Primary ballot.

May affiliate with the Democratic or Republican Party by **JUNE 19th** and receive that party's ballot.

Libertarian
Independent Amer.
United Utah

The party affiliation selected on your most recent registration form determines the ballot you will receive.

June Primary Election Update: Stay Safe – Vote from home – Vote By Mail



Because of COVID-19, state law requires that the June Primary Election be conducted entirely by mail. Weber County plans to provide emergency-only in-person voting services to voters who need accommodations due to a disability or problems with their ballot.

If you do not belong to the Republican or Democratic party, we will not mail you a ballot unless you contact us.

How can you make sure you vote is counted?

- **Verify/Update your information ASAP.** Go to www.vote.utah.gov to verify and update your address and party affiliation. All changes must be made by June 19th.
- **Return your ballot by mail or by secure drop box** (located at your city hall or county library). Don't forget to wear your "I Voted" sticker – it's included with your ballot!
- **Go to trusted sources for your election information.** www.weberelections.com and www.vote.utah.gov
- **Contact us early with any questions** (801-399-8034 or elections@weberelections.com)
